The SIC will be guided by a [Leadership Council](#) with responsibility for setting research priorities and will appoint a Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) to ensure that research methods meet the highest standards. The Solutions and Innovations Center's first major initiative will be to study one of the greatest drivers of unnecessary healthcare costs for employers – preventable hospital readmissions. Today, a significant number of hospital patients are readmitted for preventable reasons, costing employers billions of dollars each year. This project, which closely aligns with the goals of the federal "Partnership for Patients" initiative, is sponsored by Merck and Boehringer-Ingelheim and will identify effective ways to reduce readmissions in the near term, as well as benefit designs and reimbursement models that incentivize this improvement. Other initiatives will target important aspects of ambulatory care including improving depression screening and treatment.

"Employers need new solutions in the delivery of health care," said Mary Bradley, NEBGH Board Chair and Director of Health Care Planning at Pitney Bowes. "Northeast Business Group on Health's Solutions and Innovations Center will help employers find winning solutions to rein in costs and achieve a healthier, more productive workforce."
