Shawn J. Nowicki is the director of health policy at Northeast Business Group on Health (NEBGH)—an employer-based business coalition committed to market-based health care delivery system reform, quality improvement, and value-based purchasing. He also serves as the director of health policy for the New York Health Purchasing Alliance (HealthPass), a commercial health insurance exchange tackling the dilemma of uninsured working individuals and small business owners in New York City, Long Island, and the mid-Hudson Valley. In tandem, NEBGH and HealthPass provide both the large and small employer perspective to policymakers and other health care stakeholders.

In these roles, Mr. Nowicki oversees the monitoring and analysis of local, state, and federal legislative and regulatory developments affecting health insurance exchanges as well as employee health benefits. He also drafts and directs the development of the organizations' legislative agendas and policy positions. Mr. Nowicki's focus is ensuring that legislative and regulatory initiatives work towards enhancing value in the health care delivery system. Recently, he has been advising HealthPass and NEBGH members on federal health reform and also has been part of an NEBGH team developing an initiative to boost the value that employer purchasers receive from hospital-associated care.
