
Improving Care for those with COVID-19

Alternative definitions of a full vaccination, e.g. having been infected with SARS-CoV-2 and having 1 dose of a 2-dose protocol, are ignored to maximize comparability between countries.


Daily COVID-19 vaccine doses administered per 100 people



Daily new confirmed COVID-19 cases per million people




Shown is the rolling 7-day average. The number of confirmed cases is lower than the number of actual cases; the main reason for that is limited testing.





Vaccines Work

- 91- 96% effective at preventing serious disease
- Unvaccinated people are about 29 X more likely to be hospitalized with Covid-19 than those who are fully vaccinated
- 98-99% of people dying of COVID are unvaccinated



Dangers of not getting the population vaccinated

- More people are going to catch COVID-19
 - Some will die, some will have long-term side-effects
- Hospitals and ICU beds being used for COVID-19 patients
 - Ongoing risk and stress for healthcare workers
 - Hospital and ICU beds not available for patients with other conditions
- Risk of further lockdowns
- The more infections the higher the risk that a new variant will emerge that could be more infectious, more deadly and be able to avoid someone's immune response
- Failure to fully return to 'normal'

Vaccine Mandates



- All Federal Workers and contractors doing business with the Federal Government
- Health Care Workers at Medicare and Medicaid Participating Hospitals and other health care settings
- Large Entertainment Venues to Require Proof of Vaccination or Testing for Entry
- OSHA Ruling (Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS)) for Employers with >100 employees:
 - PTO to get vaccinated
 - Employees must be vaccinated or tested once per week

Mandates Challenges And Possible Solutions



- Tracking vaccination status:
 - In house Occ health, HR, Line manager, excel spreadsheet, data capture portal
 - External Third Party solutions For example: Alight Verify¹, IBM Digital Pass², Clear healthpass³,
 EHF Health VaxStatus⁴

Exemptions:

- There are no known medical conditions which absolutely prevent a person from getting a Covid-19 vaccine
 - Allergic to mRNA vaccine get a J&J vaccine
 - Certain chemotherapies advice still get vaccinated may need a booster
- "Sincerely held religious belief"
 - No major religious denomination in the U.S. opposes vaccination outright
 - It can't just be that it's against my religion need to articulate why
- Medical and religious documentation form physician or religious leader (but this is also open to abuse)


Vaccine Hesitancy


- Before attempting to persuade, try to understand

- Tap into people's desire to protect loved ones







