






Vision HawkTM: Predictive & Actionable Analytics





Number and Cost of Members by Relationship Class















- ➤ In 2023 **1,446 Members 23%** of HRLC members migrated to HRHC
- On average costs increased by \$32K/year/member
- Baseline Benchmark: 15% -18% migration rate
- @18% migration rate:\$11,525,665 savings
